DeBakey VA Medical Center) is seeking a **Health Services/Implementation Science Researcher** to join a grant supported multidisciplinary research team of a nationally recognized research program.

The applicant will be expected to carry out his/her own independent, high quality, nationally funded research in health services research, preferably within our mission and goals. He/she must also demonstrate evidence of research productivity, and success in obtaining external grant funding. The candidate for this position will be supported 5/8ths by the Michael E. DeBakey VA Medical Center, of which 25% may be used for clinical activities, if applicable. Priority will be given to current VA or NIH-funded investigators. Salary will be dependent upon qualifications.

Required Qualifications:

- An MD is required
- Must have a record of research in one or more of the relevant areas such as:
 - implementation science
 - health services/systems research
 - improvement science
 - healthcare access and delivery
 - mental and behavioral health
 - healthcare equity and health disparities
 - patient safety and healthcare informatics
- Must be able to compete for external funding (i.e. NIH, VA, AHRQ)
- Must be a U.S. citizen or U.S. permanent resident
